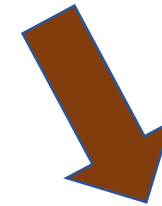


An effective Learning Objective includes 3 elements



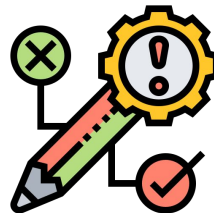
PERFORMANCE

to do?



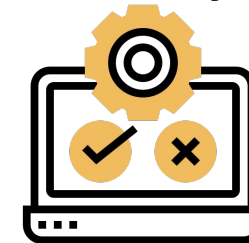
CONDITION

An example of a COMPLETE and EFFECTIVE learning objective

PERFORMANCE

Students will be able to read

PERFORMANCE + CRITERIA

Students will be able to read at least 10 cvce words

PERFORMANCE + CRITERIA + CONDITION

Students will be able to read at least 10 cvce words using different reading strategies

More examples of Learning Objectives for different Subjects



Example	Condition	Performance	Criteria
Mathematics: To organise data using tally marks	Given a set of marks obtained by 40 students	students will organise the data in a table	using tally marks
Reading Comprehension: Compare and Contrast traits of the two main characters in the story	Using the story from the textbook	students will create a Venn diagram to compare and contrast the traits of the two main characters	with at least 5 characteristics for each of them
